## FAMOUS FOLKS BURIED IN EVERGREEN

Henrietta Cuttino Dozier (1872 - 1947)



Born in Fernandina Beach, Henrietta C. Dozier graduated from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1899 with an advanced degree in architecture. She was one of only three women in the class of 176 students, and she was the only one to graduate. After working in Atlanta for thirteen years, Ms. Dozier moved her practice to Jacksonville where she became the City's first woman architect. She designed many important building and houses in Jacksonville, including the Old Federal Reserve Building. Henrietta was an Episcopalian and a licensed genealogist who traced the lineage of both her maternal and
