



Black History Month was established in 1976 by The Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History. February is the month when we celebrate the contributions and history of African Americans. The celebration was initially begun as "Negro History Week", which was established in 1926 by Carter G. Woodson, director of what was then known as the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History. The week was chosen because it included the birthdays of both Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln. This year's theme is "The Quest for Black Citizenship in the Americas"
