Mother's Day is May 10th

Among the distinguished former residents of Jacksonville that are buried in Evergreen is Sister Mary Ann; a mother figure to many. Born in Ireland in 1828, she was called the Angel of Mercy. She ministered to & nursed the afflicted soldiers of both sides during the Civil War. She walked the streets of the city during the Yellow Fever Plague of 1888 to aid citizens who were dying by the hundred. From those deaths emerged her lifelong dream, an orphanage located on Ocean St. Although burned in the 1901 fire, it was soon rebuilt.
