Among the former residents of Jacksonville buried in Evergreen is **Isaiah David Hart** (November 6, 1792-1861). Mr. Hart was an American plantation owner and the founder of Jacksonville. Originally from Georgia, he moved to this area and began setting out the plans for the town in 1822, which was then named Cowford. The original family monument was in Old City Cemetery and was vandalized many times. The Fire of 1901 destroyed the Hart Mausoleum and the family remains were moved to Evergreen.
