Recently, renovations to the historic St. Clair-Abrams mausoleum in the St. Mary's section of the cemetery have been completed. The building was erected in about 1906 and was designed by the famous local architect, Henry John Klutho. It has a design very similar to the Klutho-designed public library building at the Northeast corner of Ocean and Adams streets (now the Bedell, Ditmar, DeVault, Pillans and Coxe law firm). Mr. St. Clair-Abrams was a well known, wealthy, attorney in Jacksonville. around the turn of the 20th century.
